#### All Bourget College students begin on Monday August 26th, 2024.

## Absence/Early Dismissal/Late Arrival at Louis Querbes Pavillion

Parents must notify the Student Services office of their child's absence or early departure (resident and day student) before 8:00am, in one of the following ways:

- through messages on the pluriportail by selecting the recipient "Contacts publics (public groups)"

To ensure better monitoring of our student's attendance, it will no longer be possible to justify your child's absence via the mobile pluriportail app.

In the case of a **late arrival**, the student must go to the Student Services office in the Louis-Querbes Pavilion to pick up a late slip before going to class.

If a student needs to **leave early**, he or she must make sure that they have received the exit slip from the Student Services office before leaving the College. They must show it to their teacher before leaving the classroom.

The parent of a student in residency must ALSO notify one of the residency supervisors when leaving after 4:00 p.m. or when absent on an "arrival night".
